## Will - Future

The future with will is the first future tense in English. It is used:

- for predictions and promises.

- talk about future events that we've just decided, will be carried out.

Examples: I think I'll go to Paris next week. (a Promise)

I believe the economy will get well soon. (a Prediction)

Future with Will Structure:

Positive: Subject + Will + Verb (infinitive form)

I Jou he/she > Will go to Paris next week. We They

Negative: Subject + will + not (won't) + verb.

I Jou he/she / Will not (Won't) go to Paris next week. We They

Question: Question word + will + subject + verb ... ?
