

Will - Future

The future with **will** is the first future tense in English.

It is used:

- for predictions and promises.
- talk about future events that we've just decided, will be carried out.

Examples: I think I'll go to Paris next week. (a Promise)
I believe the economy will get well soon. (a Prediction)

Future with Will Structure:

Positive: Subject + will + verb (infinitive form)

I
You
he/she
We
They } will go to Paris next week.

Negative: Subject + will + not (won't) + verb.

I
You
he/she
We
They } will not (won't) go to Paris next week.
