Zero Conditionals - Type 0 (2) Answers

Make the zero conditional.

For example:

(not / rain / the flowers / die) If it doesn't rain, the flowers die.

1. (she/ wake up late / she / be late for work)

If she wake up late, she's late for work. / She's late for work If she wake up late.

2. (children / not eat well / they / not be healthy)

If children don't eat well, they aren't healthy. / Children aren't healthy If they don't eat well.

3. (you / mix water and electricity / you / get a shock)

You get a shock if you mix water and electricity. / If you mix water and electricity, you get a shock.

4. (my son / cook / he / burn the food)

If my son cooks, he burns the food. / My son burns the food when he cooks

5. (Faith / not wear a coat / she / get cold)

If Faith doesn't wear a coat, she gets cold. / Faith gets cold if she doesn't wear a coat.

6. (I / feel good the next day / I / go to bed early)

If I go to bed early, I feel good the next day. / I feel good the next day if I go to bed early.

7. (lots of people / come / Kate / have a party)

Lots of people come, when Kate has a party. / When Kate has a party lots of people come.

8. (she / buy expensive clothes / she / go shopping)

She buys expensive clothes, when she goes shopping. / When she goes shopping she buys expensive clothes.

9. (Junior / be sick / he / drink milk)

Junior is sick if he drinks milk. / If Dan drinks milk, he is sick.

10. (my daughter / pass her exams / she / work hard)

If my daughter works hard, she passes her exams. / My daughter passes her exams if she works hard.
